Weirder still, they've lived in the same small flat above the takeaway for the majority of those years, with Amy's mother Joan acting as their unfortunate go-between and buffer.

Now Amy's parents have moved, leaving her in charge of looking after the old man. But then Ah Goong collapses in the street and time is running out if Amy wants to play happy families before it's too late.

Julie Ma was born and raised in Carmarthen after her grandfather arrived in Wales from China in the 1920s. Her parents set up a Chinese takeaway in the 1970s and she took over the business with her brother in 2008.

As the child of parents who didn't speak English well, her love of reading and writing came from school and a legendary bookshop called Derrick Williams that allowed children to browse for hours. This her her first novel.

GROUNDING AS A FOUNDATIONAL ACT

GROUNDED
Grounding is the simplest way to make contact, and connect to the natural world. It is a place where relationship happens and unfolds. Here in the present moment you are connected to the earth beneath your feet. The past is behind you, the future is a wish, and now is where you are.

To ground is to return to the present because neither the present, nor our ability to step within it, is ever embodied. It is a natural, primal place to explore the concept of 'nature connection' and begin your relationship with the natural world. It is a simple way of making contact, everything else becomes possible. The quality of relationship is ignited when we are connected to the earth, to ourself and to others. We also learn, grow, practice, and refine our connection with the earth, and by extension with ourselves and others. Nature shows us how.



ARRIVING AT THE GROUND

There are many ways to ground yourself and others, some more physical than others. Any activity that invites you to notice what's happening around you, or inside of you, is an excellent way of grounding. This could be anything from simply to engage your senses of smell or touch to take a few deep breaths or to close your eyes and take a few moments to notice what's going on around you. This is a quick and simple process that takes you away from feeling grounded in the present.

Start by reading the activities below and notice what you are drawn to familiarise yourself, and then begin. My preference is to seek forms: compact ground or grass, hot sand, or even a soft, damp, mossy rock. You may also prefer different types of ground at certain times depending on your mood. Be playful.




holding so tightly that it remains unchanged, we are not able to adapt and survive? How can we not be wholly connected to the natural world?

The chance inherent in nature gives and takes as it is in the way. However, the world is not always in balance, and relying against the unbalance of life often leads to a sense of loss. This is not a reason to be hard on yourself. The natural world is a source of strength and resilience, and it is important to remember that our species have survived through millions of years of change. We are not alone in this.

AT STAY

The chance inherent in nature reminds us to remember our place in the world, and to be grateful to others. Change occurs so much more than we like to imagine (transforming the narrative of 'bad' and 'good', and the narrative of 'life' and 'death'). The reality of life is such that change has set up inequality for all; everyone gets a different deal. This is not a bad thing, but it can be challenging to accept that everything can be leveled. Everything can be turned upside down, those of us not special in the end. Can we let go?
